

Free cycle maintenance and training



What can I get?

- FREE Dr Bike cycle maintenance event where people can have their bikes serviced free of charge (these can be run alongside a Travel Clinic event at your site).
- FREE Travel Information packs which contain: information on the health benefits of walking and cycling, cycle maps and a guide of local 'routes and rides' to help people to get out and about in Nottinghamshire. The packs also contain local bus timetables, a bus and train leaflet and information on car sharing.
